INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

Mountain Wolf is the trading name of TOO Mountain Wolf, a company incorporated and registered in K.Amazholov Street 174, 090000 Uralsk, Kazakhstan (“Mountain Wolf”, “we”, “us” or “our” as the context may require).

Mountain Wolf uses cookies on our website (the “Website”), to distinguish you from other users. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Website and also allows us to improve it.

By continuing to browse the Website, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer’s hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our Website.

Disabling cookies

You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our Website. Thus, it is recommended that you do not disable cookies.

The cookies we set

If you create an account with us, then we will use cookies for the management of the signup process and general administration of your usage. These cookies will usually be deleted when you log out, however, in some cases they may be stored afterwards to remember your Website preferences when logged out.

We use cookies when you are logged in so that we can remember this fact. This prevents you from having to log in every single time you visit a new page. These cookies are typically removed or cleared when you log out to ensure that you can only access restricted features and areas when logged in.

When you submit data to our Website or through a form such as those found on contact pages or comment forms, cookies may be set to remember your user details for future correspondence.

Third Party Cookies

In some special cases, we also use cookies provided by trusted third parties.

We may also use social media buttons and/or plugins on this site that allow you to connect with your social network in a number of ways. For these to work the following social media sites including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Telegram, Medium, Reddit and LinkedIn will set cookies through our Website which may be used to enhance your profile on their sites or contribute to the data they hold for various purposes outlined in their respective privacy policies.
